SLOW ZOOM TO MEDIUM FRAME

JON SNOW
(He raises his eyes to camera, speaks dramatically)

Winter is coming...

QUICK CUT TO TIGHT FRAME

JON SNOW

(He cocks his head to the side, speaks comically)

I'm not kidding...

(He raises his eyebrows for emphasis)

...it's really going to get cold around here...

2. INT. STONE PASSAGEWAY. DUSK.

The MAN walks down a stone passageway. Torch sconces light the walls.

FOLLOW IN MEDIUM FRAME

JON SNOW

(walking, again speaking dramatically)

When the lake wind howls, when the snow falls a hundred feet deep and when the white armies march from the North...

JON SNOW

(stops walking, speaks to camera, nods toward hole in wall)

Will your drafty, old windows...keep them out?

3. INT. MODERN HOME. DAY

The MAN'S medieval clothing now appears out of place in this modern, comfortable setting.

MEDIUM FRAME

JON SNOW

(pleading importance)
To survive, you'll need Peak
Performance Elite-Glass
windows from Excel Windows.
They combine Triple-glazing,
Low-E glass and krypton gas
to offer an insulating value

4. INT. MODERN HOME. DAY

MEDIUM FRAME

JON SNOW
(taps window frame with sword)

6. EXT. BATTLEFIELD. DAY

A beautiful WOMAN with long blonde hair stands with her back to the camera in front of a line of soldiers standing at attention holding spears and round shields. Her bluish gown in stark contrast to the dull grey armor on her soldiers.

SLOW ZOOM TO TIGHT FRAME

JON SNOW

(voice over)

Sure, we've got great reviews from Angie's List and Yelp, but our greatest fan is the Mother of Dragons, First of her Name, Protector of Chicago and Lady of the Suburbs... JON SNOW
(voice over)
Yes, she who would be Queen
loves Excel Windows.

The WOMAN turns her head over her shoulder to face camera, smiles and winks. It is seen that she is an ugly woman with dark eyebrows and beard.
